As part of our computing curriculum and continued work on e-safety we would like to offer a computing workshop 'Keeping up with the Kids' on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November for KS2 pupils and Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> November for KS1 pupils.

This workshop will consist of an hour parent's session in the hall followed by an hour pupil and parent session and will include;

- Discussing ways to manage security and privacy setting on their home Internet and mobile devices.
- Ways to develop a relationship with their children in using technology in the home.
- Pupils and parents will work together to create digital content.

From this session parents can expect to develop a greater understanding of;
