## Our arrangements for consulting parents of pupils with SEND

Parents/Carers are always welcome to come into school and make an appointment to see a member of staff to discuss their child. Often this takes place as an informal, quick chat at the end of the school day. If further time is needed appointments should be made at the school office. A Outcome Support Plan may be given and this document should form a basis for discussion between the child, parent/carer and teacher about progress that has been made and future outcomes.

Parents and other agencies involved with a pupil who has an IHCP, PFA, or EHCP will be invited to an annual review that would normally take place in school. All people present are invited to help develop the support for the pupil for the following year.

Parents/carers who have EAL if they wish may have a translator. Parents/carers may also bring to the meeting a parental supporter.
