English: All children will be continuing to develop their phonics skills this half term and our Year 1 children will be getting ready for the screening check next half term.

Our first week back will be Holy Week and the children will be listening to the Easter story and then sequencing, retelling and writing about this religious story. Children will also be listening to and writing poems related to Easter. Children will be continuing to focus on Bug Club this half term.

Children in year 1 and 2 will be using the text 'The Queens Knickers' this half term and will be using adjective to describe characters and setting as well as asking questions and making predictions.

Year 2 – Children will be focussing on preparing for their upcoming SATS – we will be working through old reading papers and focussing on developing our writing.

DT & Art:

Years 1 and 2 will be looking at sculpture to develop and share their ideas and imagination. They will be creating their own crown and royal objects made from clay.

Music: Children will try and create their own music from the Golden Age using a variety of different instruments. We will look at what instruments in this particular era were used and how they were used.

Physical Education:

Year 1 – Children will join in with different ball games.

Year 2- Premier sports will continue to work with year 2 focussing on games.

Maths: Children in year 1 and 2 will be continuing to develop their quick mental maths skills this half term. Year 1 will continue to focus on number bonds to 10 and 20 and year 2 will be focussing on developing their 2, 5 and 10 times tables. Children in year 2 will continue using Times Table Rockstars and children in year 1 will start to be introduced to this. All children will be continuing to focus on developing their reasoning skills this half term.

Year 1 – Children will be focusing on length and height, weight and volume this half term. We will be doing lots of practical lessons so we can show a great understanding of this topic.

Year 2 – Children will be spending this half term preparing for the SATS. We will be recapping a variety of topics and using old maths SATS papers to practice answering questions and then working through the answers.

Science:

Year 1 – Children will be learning about types of animals this term. We will be identifying various animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

Year 2 – This half term we will be learning all about plants, looking specifically at how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants. We will investigate what a plant needs to grow and stay healthy. We will discover where seeds come from and will sort them to allow us to plant them and describe how they grow.

Computing: Year 1 – children will spend this half term developing their skills of logging onto the computers and while in the computer suite they will have the opportunity to use Bug Club (our school reading scheme)
Year 2 – children will spend this half term developing their typing skills through asking questions. Children will be looking at asking yes/no questions. We will then learn how to sort them into binary trees.

Impact Activity:

Children will be invited to a Kings and Queens Royal Tea Party during the last week of this half term.

PSHE: Children will spend this half term learning about mental health and how to look after themselves.

History/Geography:

This half term Years 1 and 2 will be looking at the historic Golden Age. Children will learn about when the Golden Age was and what happened in this time period that significantly impacted life today. We will be learning all about the Kings and Queens who ruled in Britain around this time and the actions they made which shaped our future. We will also be learning all about St George and his journey to become the saint of England.

The Way the Truth the Life:

We will follow our planned syllabus of The Way The Truth The Life.

Year 1 – Children will be looking at the Resurrection of Jesus this half term. We will look at how Jesus rose from the dead on the first Easter Sunday and what this means for us.

Year 2 – Children will be learning about the Easter story whilst celebrating Holy Week and learning more about the significant events of this week. They will be able to retell the story of ascension and Pentecost and will learn about symbols and signs related to the Holy Spirit.
