The answer is 26.

What was my number?

## Real-life Maths

A spider has 8 legs.  
How many legs do 5 spiders have?

Now work out how many legs 6 spiders have.

## Real-life Maths

A box holds 35 nuts.  
How many nuts are left if you eat 17?

How many nuts are there in 3 boxes?

How many boxes are needed to hold 70 nuts?

## Real-life Maths

There are 19 books on the top shelf and 32 books on the bottom shelf.

24 of the books are removed.

How many books are left?

## Real-life Maths

There are 18 apples, 21 pears and 19 bananas in some boxes of fruit.

How many pieces of fruit are there altogether?

## Real-life Maths

I think of a number, double it and add 5.

The answer is 35.

What was my number?
